


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Importance of Hajj and Umrah in Ahadith

Someone asked Imam Baqir (A.S.): "Why Hajj has been named "The Hajj of God's House'?" (Hajj-e-Baitullah) Imam said: "It means that the pilgrim has reached salvation."

Imam Ali ibn Hussain Zainul Abedin (A.S.) says: "Perform Hajj and Umrah rituals in order to be safe and sound, to make it better living for your family and make a better life."

The Holy Prophet of Islam (S.A.W.) stated: "Everyone who wants the world and the hereafter should perform hajj rituals."

Imam Sadiq (A.S.) says: "When you decide to go to Hajj, free your heart from anything that may keep you away from God."

The Holy Prophet of Islam (S.A.W.) says:
"On 4 occasions the doors of sky are opened and prayers will be accepted; on the occasion of coincidence of the rows of fighters in the cause of God, when it rains and in the time of getting up for saying prayers and at the time of looking at the great Kaaba."

Imam Sadiq (A.S.) says: "As long as a person is looking at Kaaba he will receive rewards and his sins are forgiven."

Imam Sadiq (A.S.) says: "God has provided 120 types of blessings around Kaaba, 60 of these blessings will be given to circumambulators, 40 of them will be given to prayers and 20 of these blessings will be for people who look at Kaaba."

Imam Sadiq (A.S.) says: "Entering Kaaba is like entering into God's Mercy."

Imam Sadiq (A.S.) says: "A Haji never becomes poor."

Imam Sadiq (A.S.) says: "If someone performs Hajj twice, he will be in mercy and blessing as long as he is alive."

Imam Sadiq (A.S.) says: "Someone who goes to Hajj for three times, he never becomes poor."

Imam Sadiq (A.S.) says: "Someone who goes to Hajj for ten times, God will forgive all his sins."

Imam Sadiq (A.S.) says: "I've never seen anything remove and replace poverty with wealth as fast as continuously going to the pilgrimage of God's house."

HAJJ-UT-TAMATU

This pilgrimage consists of two parts; the first is called Umrah and the second Hajj. The Hajjut-Tamatu' applies to the second part; however, it is obligatory to perform the Umrah before the Hajj.

Five matters must be observed in Umrat-ut-Tamatu':

 $Ihram\,must\,be\,worn\,at\,one\,of\,the\,Meeqats.$

Tawaf round the Ka'ba;

Prayer (salah) after the tawaf; sa'ee between Safa and Marwah;

Taqseer, that is, to remove some hair of the head, beard or moustache. On completion of these five acts, one is out of the state of ihram and all that which is forbidden during ihram becomes lawful.

It is obligatory on the pilgrim to be prepared to undertake the requirements of the pilgrimage on approaching the ninth of Dhil Hijjah.

There are thirteen compulsory acts of worship in obligatory pilgrimage:

- 1. Wearing Ehram in Makkah.
- 2. Staying in Arafat from noon on the ninth of Dhil Hijjah till sunset. Arafat is situated about twelve miles from Makkah;
- Staying in Muzdalifah part of the eve of Eidul-Adhha till sunrise on the day of the Eid.
 Muzdalifah is situated between Arafat and Makkah;
- Stoning (rami) Jamrat-ul-Aqabah in Mina on the day of the Eid. Mina is situated about three miles from Makkah;
- Slaughtering an animal in Mina on the day of Eid;
- 6. Shaving the head or removing some hair in Mina. On completion of these acts, matters forbidden during ihram become lawful except [having sexual intercourse with one's] woman, perfume and hunting;
- 7. Tawaf (tawaf-uz-ziyarah) on returning to Makkah;
- 8. Prayers after tawaf;

- Sa'ee between Safa and Marwah. At this stage wearing perfume becomes lawful;
- 10. Tawafun Nisa;
- 11. Prayers after Tawafun Nisa;
- 12. Remaining in Mina during nights of eleventh and twelfth of Dhil Hijjah.
- 13. Stoning all the three Jamarat on the eleventh and twelfth of Dhil Hijjah.

Recommendations before Putting on the Ihram

There are many recommendations before putting on the ihram. The most important ones are the following:

- To clean one's body, clip the nail, and get rid
 of the hair in the armpits and the pubic
 area.
- 2. To do the major ritual ablution (ghusl) for ihram with the sincere intention of pleasing the Almighty by saying the following: "I am doing the major ritual ablution for the ihram of 'umrah at-tamattu' of 'hajj at-tamattu' in order to seek nearness to Almighty Allah."
- 3. To put on the ihram after doing an obligatory prayer. If it is not yet the time for obligatory prayer, then he should pray six raka'at or two rak'at in which he recites in the first, after al-hamd, surah at-Tawhid and in the second, after al-hamd, surah al-Kafirun.

There are other recommendations which cannot be numerated here for sake of brevity.

Prohibitions during Ihram


As has already been discussed, Ehram is established by Talbiyah or what is considered of its kind, despite the niyyah to wear Ehram. Once Ehram is worn **twenty five** things become forbidden:

- 1. Hunting.
- 2. Sexual union.
- 3. Kissing a woman.
- 4. Touching a woman.
- 5. Looking at a woman and flirting with her.
- 6. Masturbating.
- 7. Reciting nikah.
- 8. Wearing perfume.
- 9. Wearing sewn clothes by men.
- 10. Wearing antimony (surma).
- 11. Looking in the mirror.
- 12. Wearing shoes, slippers or socks.
- 13. Outrage (Fusouq).

- 14. Quarrelling.
- 15. Killing insects found on humans, [such as lice].
- 16. Beautifying oneself.
- 17. Applying oil.
- 18. Removing hair from the body.
- 19. Covering the head, for males, or dipping one's body in water, even for females.
- 20. Covering of the face by females.
- 21. Sheltering in the shaded place for males.
- 22. Bleeding one's body.
- 23. Cutting nails.
- 24. Extracting tooth, according to some scholars.
- 25. Carrying arms.

Whenever one intends to make a journey, especially for Hajj or Ziyarat then first, one must pray to Allah for safety and well being, then make a will, give sadaka and then when one is ready to leave he should say 4 rakaats namaaz in the house in this manner – in each of the 4 rakaats recite sura Al – Hamd and then sura – Tawheed.

After namaz recite the following:



Then stand at the door of the house and recite sura Al-Hamd and Ayat al-Kursi 3 times facing the front, the right and left sides and then the following dua:

CONCLUSION OF WIDAA OF THE HOLY KAABA


Recommended acts of widaa of Makkah and the Holy Kaaba are so many, we content ourselves by mentioning a few:

- Before a pilgrim leaves he should buy dates and give them to the poor for it acts as an atonement and penance (Kaffarah) for the scratching which might have taken place unknowingly.
- 2. Should intent to come back to Makkah and ask Allah (s.w.t.) to enable him to do this according to a tradition which says that doing this prolongs one's lifetime. According to a tradition narrated from Imam Sadiq (a.s.) it is makrooh to leave without this intention. It says: He who leaves Makkah with an intention of not coming back, his appointed time and punishment nears.
- 3. Tawaf seven times around the Kaaba.

- 4. Touching the Black Stone and the right side corner (Ruknil Aiman) in each round if possible, otherwise it is enough to do so in the first and last rounds possibilities too.
- 5. He may do the above recommended acts while in Tawaf or in Mustajar if possible.
- Praise and thank Allah, recite Swalawat for the Holy Prophet and his family members and recite any supplication he wishes.

He should then say:
